WHAT IS KICKSTART?

The Kickstart scheme is part of the government's Plan for Jobs which aims to create thousands of job opportunities for young people in organisations across the UK by offering employers additional funding until September 2022.

The aim of Kickstart is to support young people by encouraging employers to create new roles to develop well rounded, qualified and capable individuals, who bring real value to the organisations they work for.

Under the Kickstart scheme, any organisation creating a new role for 16-24-year old will be able to access government funding covering the cost of Kickstarts wages (at minimum wage) for 25 hours a week for a period of 6 months.

Organisations will also pay no employer National Insurance or pension enrolment contributions for Kickstarts during their 6 months employment as a Kickstart and have access to additional funding from the government to help support their employee to cover the costs of any equipment the Kickstart may need, PPE or further training.
